



ANNUAL CENTRAL COAST SECTION ATHLETIC DIRECTORS' ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

PURPOSE: To recognize and reward student athletes who overcome challenges to balance academic achievement, athletic participation and community service.

SCHOLARSHIPS: One student from each conference (North, Central and Southern) of the CCS will receive a \$500 scholarship.

Deadline for submission of applications to CCS-ADA Conference Representative is April 1st

Applications must be turned in to your school's Athletic Director prior to April 1st or to the CCS-ADA Conference Rep by April 1st. The CCS-ADA Conference Representative's contact information can be found on the CCSADA website at: www.cifccs.org/CCSADA%20Index.htm

ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible for consideration, a nominee must:

- Currently enrolled as a senior student in good standing and a candidate for graduation from a Central Coast Section member high school
- Currently earning a 7 Semester cumulative GPA (grades 9-12) of 2.5 or higher
- Currently in 3 varsity sports during his/her senior year.

(Applicant must earn a Varsity Letter during Fall and Winter seasons of Senior year)

- Currently committed to school investment through school leadership or school service.
- Currently a commitment to community investment through volunteer service (e.g. volunteer work in social, youth, church and/or other community service).
- Currently, your school's AD must be a CCSADA member
- Enroll in and begin study at a two-year or four-year college within one year of graduating from high school.

CONDITIONS:

- The \$500 scholarships are to be used toward tuition, fees and/or books at the college of the student's choice.
- The \$500 scholarships are to be used for the following school year and are non-transferable.
- The scholarship funds will be distributed to selected students after the Central Coast Section Athletic Directors Association receives proof of acceptance from the colleges the students will be attending.

PROCESS:

The evaluation committee will review all applications and choose the three individual recipients. Scholarship recipients will be notified the week of May 1st. Each application must be accompanied by:

1. The formal student application.
2. Letter of recommendation from a coach, athletic director or school administrator.
3. Student Essay (500 words) – Topic, “The role athletics has played in my life”
4. Copy of High School Transcript.
