Section 1 NUMBER OF PLAYOFFS

The Section shall establish an equitable number of Championship playoffs for boys and girls teams.

Section 2 EQUITY IN NUMBERS OF CONTESTS IN LEAGUES

Leagues which establish minimum and/or maximum numbers of contests for sports shall do so on a sex-neutral basis. In like sports, the total number of league and non-league contest minimums and/or maximums shall be equal for boys and girls competition.

Section 3 OFFICIALS

League, Schools or School Districts shall contract or otherwise arrange for the assignment of officials to member school contests and shall provide equal access to the services provided by officials. Assignment of officials to contests for boys and girls sports shall be on a sex

Section 4 SEASONS OF SPORT

Leagues shall establish seasons of sport which shall provide for equitable competition for boys and girls. Like sports shall have equal season lengths when conducted during the same season. Like sports shall have similar season lengths when conducted in different seasons.

Section 5 AWARDS

Athletic awards for Section competition shall be established by policy of the Board of Managers. When awards are made, they shall be determined on a sex

Section 6 WRESTLING WEIGH INS

No male weigh masters and/or male officials will conduct or be present at female weigh-ins; likewise, no female weigh masters and/or female officials will conduct or be present during male weigh-ins. This does not apply if wrestlers are weighing in wearing their uniform. If a skin inspection or any other type of test that requires the removal of the uniform is necessary, such procedures shall be done in a place where only same-gender supervisory personnel are present.
