CCS PASS POLICY

(11/79; 5/18; 9/89; 4/92, 10/11)

1. SECTION ADULT PASSES

CCS passes shall be issued to school personnel as listed below. Complimentary admission to all interscholastic athletic events conducted within the Section shall be granted to the Pass Holder and guest. League, school, district and booster club passes shall not be honored at CCS events.

CCS passes are valid only for adults as specified on the pass. Misuse of a CCS pass will result in forfeiture of the pass. School personnel pass holders:

- (a) Superintendents--(four (4) passes) for District Athletic Supervisors
- (b) Principals--(three (3) passes) for school athletic personnel
- (c) County Superintendents (1 pass)
- (d) League Commissioners (1 pass)
- (e) CCS Board of Managers (individual pass)
- (f) College and University coaches as requested for recruiting purposes
(upon request -- maximum of 10 each)
- (g) Others as designated by the Commissioner necessary to support
Section activities and events. (individual passes)

Passes will be automatically issued from the CCS Office per the above list.

2. SECTION WORKING PRESS

CCS Working Press Passes shall be issued to media representatives who regularly provide coverage of interscholastic athletics. Requests for such passes shall be considered when presented in writing on media letterhead signed by a responsible official of the media. **Passes will not be issued for scouting services, individual internet sites, or other non-public media entities. Passes will be issued at the discretion of the CCS Commissioner and may be revoked at any time if the pass privileges are abused.**

3. HONORARY LIFETIME (GOLD PASS)

Honorary Lifetime CCS Passes shall be issued by the Section to persons qualified as follows:

- (a) CCS Presidents
- (b) Board of Managers representatives upon completion of five years service on the Board commencing with the 1970-71 school year.
- (c) CCS Commissioner, Assistant Commissioner and other full-time staff who have been employed by the Section for a minimum of five years.
- (d) League Commissioners who have served their league for a minimum of five years.
- (e) Special persons as recommended to the CCS Executive Committee for outstanding service to the Central Coast Section. Service to individual schools and/or leagues shall not be considered in such recommendations.

4. PASS GATE LISTS

Pass Gate List forms will be provided to the Administrator of each school with a team that has qualified for a CCS Team Playoff Championship. The Pass Gate List for the Team Playoffs is for use by the Principal when additional staff will be attending a CCS Team Playoff Event in order to assist in the supervision of spectators.

Six additional supervisors will be admitted if listed on the pass gate list, signed by the Principal and presented in a timely fashion to the CCS Gate Personnel for that contest. Any requests for additional supervisory personnel, must be presented by the Principal of the school in writing (e-mail or letter) and approved by the CCS Commissioner.
