1. Officials- Discussion took place in reference to cost of officials. Some coaches expressed concerns that the cost of lacrosse officials seem higher than more than other sports. Steve Filios pointed out that official organizations cannot go over the maximum fee set by the CCS Board of Managers. Some concerns about games getting cancelled at the last minute due to shortage of officials.
2. Start Dates and Maximum Number of Contests- All CCS spring sports 2010 cannot start practice until February 1. First scrimmage date is February 15 and first contest is February 22. Maximum number of contest for lacrosse is 20. Teams are also permitted to 2 scrimmages plus an alumni game or faculty game and league jamboree. Post league tournaments do not count toward the total number of contests.
