D. DIVISION PLACEMENT

The previous school year's [grades 9-12 CBEDS enrollment figures](#), will be used to as established below by the CCS Girls Volleyball Committee, will be used to place schools in their respective Divisions: **This determination will be done by the CCS Staff, no later than April 15 as outlined below:**

- **Adjust the size of each division insuring that each division has the same number of school**
- **If more than one school has the same enrollment at the "point of division", all schools with that enrollment would be placed in the higher of the two divisions.**
- **If the number of schools was not a multiple of five, the "extra" school(s) would be placed beginning in the higher division(s). (i.e. If there are 103 schools participating in a sport, 21 would be placed in Division 1, 21 in Division 2, 21 in Division 3, 20 in Division 4 and 20 in Division 5).**
- **Division placement of all member schools for girls volleyball will take place no later than April 15 of each year.**
- **When determining the divisions, the CCS staff will utilize a list of enrollments without school names attached to insure objectivity.**
