Section 2. TOURNAMENT DATES

The 2010 CCS Boys/Girls Soccer Tournament will be conducted as follows:
1st Round: TUESDAY / WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 23/24, 2010
Quarter-Finals: SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 27, 2010
Semi-Finals: TUE. / WED. / THU., MARCH 2,3,4, 2010
Finals: SATURDAY, MARCH 6, 2010

Section 11. UNIFORMS

It is the responsibility of the coaches to contact their opponents to determine if there is a similarity of color in team jerseys. In the event there is a similarity, it is the home team’s responsibility to make the necessary change. *The home team (higher seed after the first round) will wear the light colored jerseys and matching socks.*

Section 12. TEAM BENCH

Teams will be seated on the same side of the field and opposite the spectators, whenever possible. *The home team (higher seed after the first round) will have choice of bench.*

II. **RECOMMENDATIONS**

This section includes general recommendations to the CCS Board of Managers or Staff that are not Tournament format related. Recommendations are just that, implemented or not at the discretion of the Staff or the CCS Board. Acceptance of this Sport Committee Report does no more than acknowledge these recommendations. These are not action items. If a recommendation is to be approved, and/or the Board wants to direct Staff to institute a particular recommendation, the CCS Board must pull out and vote upon that specific recommendation.

- a. Most 1st-Round games will be scheduled on Wednesday, February 24, 2010. Schools hosting both Boys and Girls 1st-Round games will play the Boys game on Tuesday, February 23, 2010. (This format is rotated between the Boys and Girls every year.) Exceptions may be made if the hosting school has a lighted field.
- b. Coaches should honestly evaluate home fields and notify the committee at the seeding meeting if the condition of the field is not up to acceptable standards for playoff contests and have another alternative site scheduled and confirmed for their play. If not, they will be sent to the lower seeded team's home site.
- c. Coaches should be prepared for Penalty Kicks to decide ties in advance to avoid delays.
- d. Honor Coach recommendations should be forwarded to Assistant Commissioner Duane Morgan.

IV. PROPOSED MAJOR FORMAT CHANGES

This section contains any proposal that the Staff has determined to be a major change in the core format of the CCS Play-offs in this sport. As such, any item listed below will be reviewed as a 1st-reading at the CCS Board of Managers meeting following the Sport Committee meeting. The Board will return the item(s) to the Leagues for review and discussion; the item(s) will be agendized at the next Board meeting for final discussion and action.

Proposal #1:

Section 8. OFFICIALS

- ~~D. In all subsequent rounds, up to the finals, neutral crews will be utilized, whenever possible. the association which services the higher seed will assign the officials, whenever possible.~~
 - ~~E. Assignment of Officials for finals games will be divided among the officials' associations which service CCS schools~~
 - ~~1. All such associations will be drawn for random assignment of the six CCS finals games.~~
 - ~~2. These assignments will be rotated after this initial draw for the ensuing years.~~
- Rationale: The committee felt that this was a more equitable way to assign the officials, and provide the best quality of officiating for the tournament. No change in costs. (Passed 11-4-2)**

Proposal #2:

Section 3. TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- A. ~~36~~ **39** Boys qualifying teams will be divided into
 3 Divisions of ~~42~~ **13** teams each. **27 Automatics** **12 at large**

~~36~~ **39** Girls qualifying teams will be divided into
 3 Divisions of ~~42~~ **13** teams each. **30 Automatics** **9 at large**

Rationale: More schools play soccer than any other sport, and the number of teams should increase to reflect the growth in participation. There has been no increase in the number of teams in the playoffs for several years. There would be a significant increase in cost. (passed 17-0-0)

Proposal #3:

Section 7. RULES:

- G. In any game prior to the Championship game, ties will be broken in the following manner:
 - Two (2) mandatory 10-minute overtime periods will be played until completed;
 - ~~If still tied, there will be two (2) five-minute “sudden victory” periods.~~
 - If still tied, the game will be decided by penalty kicks.
- H. In the Championship Game, Co-Champions will be declared whenever a tie exists after the completion of the two (2) 10-minute overtime periods ~~and two (2) 5-minute sudden-victory overtime periods.~~

League Commissioners Amendment

Section 7. RULES:

- G. In any game prior to the Championship game, ties will be broken in the following manner:
 - Two (2) mandatory ~~10-minute~~ **5-minute** overtime periods will be played until completed;
 - ~~If still tied, there will be two (2) five-minute “sudden victory” periods.~~
 - If still tied, the game will be decided by penalty kicks.
- H. In the Championship Game, Co-Champions will be declared whenever a tie exists after the completion of the two (2) ~~10-minute~~ **5-minute** overtime periods ~~and two (2) 5-minute sudden victory overtime periods.~~

Rationale: **The NFHS rule book states that the maximum overtime is only 20 minutes. Our by-laws were in violation of this rule. The committee felt that the 5-minute overtime periods were not sufficient to determine a champion properly. No increase in cost. (Passed 17-0-0)**
