- B. Each League qualifies the top three (3) individuals finishers from their League Championship Meet (not on a qualifying team).

II. PROPOSED MAJOR FORMAT CHANGES:

This section contains any proposal that the staff has determined to be a major change in the core format of the CCS Play-offs in this sport. As such, any item listed below will be reviewed as a 1st-reading at the CCS Board of Managers meeting following the Sport Committee meeting. The Board will return the item(s) to the Leagues for review and discussion; the item(s) will be agendized at the next Board meeting for final discussion and action.

Proposal #1: The committee voted 12-yes to 0-no, to approve the recommendations of the Blue Ribbon committee on Division placement of schools. Thus the following proposal:

Section 3. DIVISION PLACEMENT

- A. The previous year's grade 9-12 CBEDS enrollment figures, ~~as listed below~~, will be used to for Division placement:
 - Adjust the size of each division insuring that each division has the same number of schools.**
 - o **If more than one school has the same enrollment at the "point of division", all schools with that enrollment would be placed in the higher of the two divisions.**
 - o **If the number of schools was not a multiple of five, the "extra" school(s) would be placed beginning in the higher division(s). (i.e. If there are 103 schools participating in a sport, 21 would be placed in Division 1, 21 in Division 2, 21 in Division 3, 20 in Division 4 and 20 in Division 5).**
 - o **Division placement of all member schools for cross country will take place no later than April 15 of each year.**
 - o **When determining the divisions, the CCS staff will utilize a list of enrollments without school names attached to insure objectivity.**
 - o **Note: The state has put enrollment caps on Division 4 (1250) and Division 5 (500), however, if divided into five equal divisions by enrollment, our Division 4 and 5 member schools must still fall within those guidelines.**

Note: The league Commissioners proposed an amendment that all schools with an enrollment of 500 or less remain in Division V in Cross Country, Volleyball, and Basketball. In Cross Country, the CIF cap for Division V (500) plus the demographics of the member schools in our section makes the staff adjusted numbers viable for this year.

- B. The committee voted 12-yes to 0-no to recommend an increase of individual medals to 10 in each division (first ten finishers) and to increase team awards to 3 (first three places) in each division plus any state qualifier.

**A.	20 32 Team Trophies: Champion and Runner-Up Teams Top three teams in all Divisions and other state qualifiers
**B.	70 Medals: 1st through 7th place finishers, 80 Medals: 1st through 10th place finishers, Girls and Boys, in all Divisions.

This proposal will be forwarded to the CCS Awards Committee for consideration. (see financial report at end of this report).
