Proposal 1:

Notification of the withdrawal of any singles or doubles team must be made to the CCS office via phone, fax or e-mail no later than 6:00 PM of the day before each day of the competition. Failure to meet this deadline and/or simply not showing up the day of the competition will result in the elimination of that school's participation the following year in the CCS Tournament.

Rationale: This will help insure that players follow through on their commitment to participate, and will allow a league to substitute an available alternate for the first day of the tournament. This policy is already in place in tennis, and will not result in any increase of costs.
