Coaches should honestly evaluate home fields and notify the committee at the seeding meeting if the condition of the field is not up to acceptable standards for playoff contests and have another alternative site scheduled and confirmed for their play. If not, they will be sent to the lower seeded team's home site.
- c. Honor Coach recommendations should be forwarded to Assistant Commissioner Duane Morgan.
