I. TOURNAMENT GUIDE CHANGES –continued

Section 8.B The Jury of Appeals (clarification)

1.

1. At Semi-Finals and Finals, - Will consist of the Meet Director, the Chairperson of the CCS Track & Field Committee, and a designated CCS Staff member. **The meet director shall appoint a jury of appeals with the approval of the CCS office.** Appeals will be addressed immediately, and are final, with no further action to follows.

Scoring procedure: The T& F Committee voted (10-0) to score 8 places when calculating the team standings at the CCS Finals to mirror the change made for the 2010 CIF State meet.

Note: The current CCS T&F bylaws do not list a method for scoring the CCS Finals leaving it to the Games Committee as prescribed in the NFHS rule book. In order to insure that the meet is scored in accordance with the direction of CCS governing bodies, CCS staff recommends the following be added to the CCS Track and Field bylaws:

Section 11. AWARDS

Awards will be presented at the Finals, for both Girls and Boys, as follows:

A. Team Trophies: Champion, Runner-Up, 3rd- and 4th-Place:

1. **Scoring for 8 places shall be as follows: 10, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1.**
2. **In case of a tie by two (2) or more competitors for any place scoring in an event, the points for all places involved shall be divided equally among the tying competitors.**

IV. PROPOSED MAJOR FORMAT CHANGES

Not Approved

Proposal #1: In all events other than the 1600 and 3200 meters, increase the number of qualifiers from semifinals to finals from 8 to 9

Section 4. QUALIFYING FROM SECTION SEMI-FINALS TO SECTION FINALS

A. RUNNING EVENTS

- 1. **Running Events (except the 1600m and 3200m):** ~~Eight [8]~~ **Nine (9)** finalists. Winners of each heat, plus the next fastest times, qualify for the Finals.
- 2. **1600m:** Two [2] equal heats. Top two [2] finishers in each heat, plus the next eight [8] fastest, qualify for the Finals.
- 3. **3200m:** Two [2] equal heats. Top two [2] finishers in each heat, plus the next eight [8] fastest, qualify for the Finals.

B. FIELD EVENTS

- 1. **Long Jump, Triple Jump, Shot Put, and Discus:** Four [4] attempts. The top eight ~~[8]~~ **nine (9)** qualify for the Finals.
- 2. **High Jump and Pole Vault:** Events go to completion. Top eight ~~[8]~~ **nine (9)** qualify for the Finals.

Rationale: Gilroy HS has been established as a quality site for the CCS Championships. It has nine lanes and therefore, can accommodate nine finalists as is done at the CIF State Meet. Historically, the Track and Field Committee has patterned the CCS Meet to mirror the logistics of the CIF State Meet. In addition, the additional parents/spectators attending the CCS Finals in support of the additional finalists could provide more revenue for the meet. (This proposal passed by a 10-0 vote)
