## IV. PROPOSED MAJOR FORMAT CHANGES

This section contains any proposal that the Staff has determined to be a major change in the core format of the CCS Play-offs in this sport. The Board will return the item(s) to the Leagues for review and discussion; the item(s) will be agendized at the next Board meeting for final discussion and action.

### PROPOSAL # 1

#### Section 4. QUALIFICATION OF INDIVIDUALS

- D. *An at-large entry may be permitted into the tournament if a returning CCS Medalist does not qualify for the CCS tournament through the qualifying procedures of the league tournament. The at-large candidate would be the next qualifying wrestler for the league. This entrant would increase the size of the bracket.*

#### Rationale:

In various leagues some weight classes may be very competitive and have wrestlers who would be solid competitors at the CCS Championships. This would be more prevalent in leagues which only qualify two wrestlers per weight class due to the two-year formula that is applied for the number of entrants allowed in each weight class per league. This is based on overall league performance at the prior two CCS Tournaments. This has occurred when a returning CCS Medalist has not been allowed to enter the tournament because he was beaten by another CCS Medalist in his league, and the league did not qualify for another entry. (passed 10-0)
