League reps put their automatic and at-large applicants on the board, and prepare for the selection and seeding of each division.

~9:10 am Selecting and seeding process begins – Coaches for the division under discussion are now allowed in for observation.

At the conclusion of each division, the room will be cleared to give the committee ~10 minutes to prepare for the next division.

1:30 PM - **League Reps Only** -All Divisions. All **Girls** Basketball League reps meet for instruction and discussion of seeding procedures for the day. Copies of Season Summary sheets are collected from league reps, copied and distributed to the committee. League reps put their automatic and at-large applicants on the board, and prepare for selection and seeding of each division.

Section 5. SEEDING AND BRACKETING PROCEDURES		
A.	At-Large selection and seeding criteria to be considered by the Basketball Sport Committee, in no specific order, include the following:	
	head-to-head competition	common opponents
	strength of schedule	strength of League
		significant wins

B..	<u>The All teams which meet the criteria and apply for entry through submission of a CCS Season Summary Form, in each Division will be subjectively selected (for at-large berths) by the CCS Basketball Committee and seeded by the Basketball Committee at the Seeding meeting.-(See Section 1.)</u>	
	1.	League mates being considered for any at-large berth must be selected in order of league finish.
C.	<u>The top 8 teams in each Division will be subjectively seeded by the CCS Basketball Committee with the top four (4) seeded teams in each Division receiving a bye, into the Quarter-finals. A League/Division may have only one (1) team, in order of League finish, on the board at any one time for consideration for seeding.</u>	
D.	<u>The remaining non-seeded teams in each Division will be placed in the brackets considering the following criteria in rank order</u>	
	1.	<u>Teams will be separated into half brackets from the majority of their league mates whenever possible.</u>
	2.	<u>Teams will not meet league mates in the first or second rounds whenever possible.</u>
	3.	<u>Teams will be matched up in their half bracket with travel being the next criteria considered.</u>
	4.	<u>If there are two rounds prior to quarter finals, In that second round, seeded teams will host.</u>
	5.	<u>In the first round, hosting teams will be determined as follows:</u>
	a.	<u>If the teams meeting in the first round are league mates, hosting will be determined as follows:</u>
	i.	<u>The league mate with the higher league finish will host.</u>
	ii.	<u>If the league mates tied in their league finish, head to head results will determine which team will host.</u>
	iii.	<u>If there is no head to head comparison (i.e. the teams split) a coin will be flipped to determine which team will host. The team whose full school name is first alphabetically will call the toss.</u>
	b.	<u>If the teams meeting in the first round are not league mates, but are both members of a super league hosting will be determined as follows:</u>
	i.	<u>The team that comes from the "higher" division of their super league will host</u>

			ii.	<u>If both teams are from the same level of division of their respective super league, head to head results will determine which team will host</u>
			iii.	<u>If there are no head to head results a coin flip will determine which team will host. The team whose full school name s first alphabetically will call the toss.</u>
		c.		<u>If the teams meeting in the first round are not league mates and are not both members of a super league, league hosting will be determined as follows:</u>
			i.	<u>Head to head results will determine who hosts.</u>
			ii.	<u>If there is no head to head comparison, league finish will determine which team will host</u>
			iv.	<u>If neither i. or ii breaks the tie, a coin flip will determine which team will host. The team whose full school name is first alphabetically will call the toss.</u>
D.	Wherever possible, opponents of the seeded teams referred to in Section 5.-A. will be placed so that they do not meet League mates in 1st round games.			
E.	After seeding all teams, if three (3) teams from the same League are in the same half bracket, and at least 10 of the League Representatives agree that this is a significant misplacement in the seeding of teams, then a subjective change in placement may occur by agreement of at least 10 League Representatives.			

II. RECOMMENDATIONS

This section includes general recommendations to the CCS Board of Managers or staff that are not Tournament format related. Recommendations are just that, implemented or not at the discretion of the staff or the CCS Board. Acceptance of this Sport Committee Report does no more than acknowledge these recommendations. These are not action items. If a recommendation is to be approved, and/or the Board wants to direct staff to institute a particular recommendation, the CCS Board must pull out and vote upon that specific recommendation.

- 1. A discussion took place regarding a CCS staff major format change proposal to allocate automatic qualifiers, by league and divisions (D-I, D-II, etc), to the CCS tournament, thus eliminating at-large entries. The committee decided more data needed to be looked at and to revisit at this proposal next year. A major challenge appeared to be the issue of changing league by-laws to accommodate the proposal.**
- 2. It was recommended by the sports committee that time be given to the seeding committee, without coaches present, to prepare for the selection and seeding of teams into the tournament. There will be an ~10 minute time period before each division selection/seeding, to allow the seeding committee to prepare for the next division. The coaches will then be invited in, by divisions, to observe the selection and seeding of the tournament for their division.**
- 3. It was recommended by both CCS staff and sport committee members that the times at the semi-finals be 5:30 and 7:15 pm. This will match the 1:45 minute “between games” time frame that is in place for the quarter-finals.**
