



**Section 3. QUALIFICATION OF TEAMS AND INDIVIDUALS TO TOURNAMENTS****A. MINIMUM COURSE REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL LEAGUE QUALIFYING TOURNAMENTS**

- New**
1. All League qualifying tournaments must be conducted over a minimum of 18 holes (one day) on a course with a par of 70 or higher.
    - a. League qualifying tournaments shall be played from the yardages on the scorecard for the selected tees.**
  2. If it becomes impossible for a League to complete the 18 holes required in Section 3-A-1 above, due to:
    - a. severe, inclement weather that jeopardizes the safety of the League participants; or
    - b. the golf course is canceling play; and
    - c. it is impossible to reschedule or make up the League tournament in time for the CCS seeding meeting; and
    - d. the CCS Commissioner, in discussion with the League Commissioner, determines that the circumstances meet a. through c. above; then  
 Leagues may determine qualifying teams and individuals according to the League by-laws that address such circumstances.

**B. TEAMS AND INDIVIDUALS TO SECTION TOURNAMENT: (Maximum 96 Players)**

1. **Team Tournament (Maximum 6 Teams 1 per league)**
    - a. The Champion from each League that is made up of a minimum of six (6) teams, plus At-Large teams, using the **five (5)** best scores of a six (6)-person team, qualify for the Section Championships.
    - New** b. **The top five (5) non-champion teams will enter the Section Tournament as an At-Large Team using the lowest team differential from their league tournament. The team differential is computed by subtracting 5 times the course rating from the team score, multiplying the difference by 113, dividing by the course slope and rounding to the nearest tenth.**  
 Non-Champion teams may enter the Section Tournament as At-Large if their average team score for **five (5)** players is equal to or better than **75%** (without rounding off) of the slope of the course at their League Tournament.
    - New** c. **In the event of a tie for the final at-large team qualifier, the tie will be decided by adding the differential for the sixth player's score to the team total. If the teams are still tied, the tie will be decided by coin toss.**
    - ~~c.~~ All teams (Automatic Qualifiers and At-Large selections) entering the Tournament
    - ~~d.~~ may only come from Leagues that participate in regularly-scheduled matches during the Fall sports season.
  2. **Individual Tournament**
    - a. Each League's Individual Champion qualifies to enter the Individual Tournament. **(6 champions)**
    - New** b. **If an individual is a member of a qualifying team, an additional entry is added to the pool of at-large individual entries.** Any individual player, as well as any member of a team, may enter the Individual Championship if her score is equal to or better than **75%** (without rounding off) of the slope of the course at her League Qualifying Tournament.

- c. The twenty-four (24) individuals that record the lowest differentials in the league tournaments, that are not members of a qualifying team will qualify as an at-large individual and will qualify for the Section Championship. The individual differential is computed by subtracting the course rating from the individual score, multiplying the difference by 113, dividing by the course slope and rounding to the nearest tenth.

An Individual player attending a school that does not field a Girls Golf team may enter her respective League's Qualifying Tournament, and qualify to enter the CCS Girls Individual Championship, if either:

- (1) her score is equal to or better than 75% (without rounding off) of the slope of the course at her League Tournament; or
- (2) she is the Individual League Champion.

- d. In the event of a tie for the final (24<sup>th</sup>) at-large individual qualifier, all players with the same differential score will be allowed to enter the tournament.

Such **individual** player may then participate with the Boys team at her school in the Spring season. She may not, however, participate in the Boys Individual Tournament in the Spring.
