**E. CCS SCHOLAR/ATHLETE AWARDS**

**1. 3.50 GPA Certificates**

**F. CIF MODEL COACH AWARD**

The Committee had no recommendations for any changes to the process by which the CCS chooses its nominations for the CIF Model Coach Award program.

**III. OTHER**

**A. AWARDS SUPPLIER CONTRACT**

Ass't. Commissioner Stearns reported that the State CIF agreement with our Awards Supplier, Herff-Jones, will expire at the end of this school year. Herff-Jones was the only company that submitted a bid for the state-wide sponsorship contract, and the prices Herff-Jones quoted for awards for the State CIF, the CCS and the other Sections increased significantly – for the CCS awards, the prices increased almost three-fold, across the board, for all our awards. The Section Commissioners voted to not re-new the agreement with Herff-Jones; and therefore, the CCS will be seeking a new awards supplier, as well as another supplier for our Play-off program covers. Steve reported that we are one of five Sections without a title-sponsoring, and that those Sections will be investigating forming a consortium looking to procure a generic program cover, in an attempt to contain printing costs. As well, staff will need to contact alternative awards companies. This issue will be an agenda item at next week's CCS League Commissioners meeting.

**B. LEAGUE SPORTSMANSHIP AWARD**

Ass't. Commissioner Stearns reported that the CCS Sportsmanship Committee is recommending that all Leagues within the CCS initiate League Sportsmanship Award programs, and asked for any additional input from members of the Award Committee. This will also be an agenda item at next week's CCS League Commissioners meeting.
