

GOLF SURVEY
January 2002

The purpose of this survey is to assess the impact of the changes in format to Girls' and Boys' Golf during the 2001-2002 seasons and to gather data for consideration of future adjustments to the programs.

In the 2001 NorCal and SoCal Championships, the Girls' Golf format was changed from a play four - score three format to a play six - score four format. This change was designed to increase the opportunities in golf for girls to the same level as boys. At the same time the Boys' Golf format was changed from a play six – score five format to a play six – score four format. This change was adopted to provide equity in the programs of both genders. The intent was to implement these two changes until such time that both Boys' and Girls' Golf formats could support the play six- score five format.

Each school is asked to complete and return this survey to the Central Coast Section Office by March 1, 2002.

The survey is to be completed by the school principal or school athletic director using input from individuals directly connected to the school's golf programs.
