

Two (2) items have been identified for correction within the pages of the 2010-11 NFHS Rules Book. Please read carefully below and amend your books to reflect the change...

1. **PAGE 117, Rule 11.6, Interpretation:** “A player removed for the remainder of the game may not play in any part of the game to be replayed.” THIS SENTENCE IS TO BE ELIMINATED AS NOT ALL GAME EXCLUSIONS ARE CONSIDERED MISCONDUCT.
 - a. Example: A player is removed for the remainder of the game for leaving the water and walking to the re-entry area at 1:30 in the 3rd quarter. Following the game a protest is logged for a rule misapplication occurring at 2:57 in the 2nd quarter. If it is determined the game must be replayed starting from 2:57 in the 2nd quarter, the player removed for leaving the water in the 3rd would be eligible to participate as his/her game exclusion would be “lined through” as it was NOT a flagrant misconduct, misconduct or red card.

2. **PAGE 138, Table 1, Rows 2 and 4:** This table was created as a quick reference for officials to identify what actions are to be taken in the case of a subsequent Minor Act of Misconduct (MAM) or Misconduct occurring after the calling of an exclusion or penalty foul. Rows 2 and 4 reference what actions are to be taken following a player committing his/her first (row 2) OR second (row 4) personal foul, a penalty foul. Columns 2 and 3 identify that if a subsequent MAM or Misconduct is called after the penalty foul that “the player is excluded for 20 seconds” and the substitute is to be in the re-entry area at the taking of the live penalty throw. THIS IS INCORRECT. The table was not changed, but a penalty throw was changed to become part of interval time. Once the penalty foul is committed, any subsequent foul that occurs prior to the taking of the penalty throw will have occurred during interval time. Therefore, the substitute will be in the field of play at the taking of the live time penalty throw per Rule 21-10.
