MEETINGS:

- **ENTRY FORMS DEADLINE: THURSDAY, OCTOBER 27, 2011, 5:00 PM**, due in to CCS Office. (No meeting will be held.)
 - [Official League Entry Forms](#) MUST BE SUBMITTED ELECTRONICALLY, and are due in to the CCS Office no later than the date indicated above.
 - **Note:** As stipulated in the CIF Girls Golf Bylaws, non-Champion teams may enter the Tournament if their average team score for **five (5)** players is equal to, or better than, **75%** (without rounding off) of the slope of the course at their League Tournament, and individuals must have a score equal to, or better than, **75%** of the slope of the course.

TOURNAMENT DATE & SITE: **TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 1, 2011**

If the Championships are delayed due to inclement weather, they may be rescheduled at a time when the course is available.

TIME SCHEDULE:

- **Check-in:** One-half hour before first tee time.
- **First tee-time: 8:00am.** Groups (in THREESOMES, when possible) will start on 1ST and 10TH tees.
- **Order of tee-times:**
 - *Individuals:* #1 individual qualifiers from each league, with #2's, #3's, #4's, etc. followed by:
 - *Teams:* #1 player from each qualifying team, with #2's through #6's team members to follow.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL PARTICIPANTS AND COACHES:

The CIF-Central Coast Section is well aware that many other school and non-school activities (AP tests, SAT/ACT tests, proms, plays, holidays, senior trips, religious days, etc.) may occur during CCS Playoffs. The CCS tries to avoid as many conflicts as possible; however, with so many activities available for today's student-athlete, it is not reasonable to assume that all such activities can be taken into account, and thus, CCS Play-off events will go on as originally scheduled. Participants and coaches are therefore expected to plan in advance for such possible scheduling conflicts and make those difficult choices as to which events will take precedence for that individual. Generally, although it is ultimately the personal choice of the student-athlete and/or his/her parent(s), an academic activity should take precedence over an extra-curricular event.

LEAGUE TOURNAMENT DIRECTORS MUST:

- Electronically submit your League's Team and Individual entries (all qualifiers) to the CCS office; no later than the deadline above.
- Note the starting time and procedures at the course;
- Notify qualifying teams and individuals as indicated above.

COACHES' DUTIES:

- Coaches will be assigned to marshal a hole or to walk with each group and serve as that group's official referee.
- Coaches may not play.
- Coaches must be in attendance -- NO COACH = NO PLAY.

PLAYERS' APPAREL AND EXPECTED BEHAVIOR:

- Please remember, we are GUESTS of the golf course!!!
- Attire must conform to the rules of the course being played.
- **"Soft spikes"** must be worn. No rubber-cleated shoes are to be worn.
- Smoking, profanity and/or abuse of the course will not be tolerated, and will result in immediate disqualification. No appeals will be considered.
- Please do not bring coolers, cans, bottles and the like onto the course; since we are guests at the course, it is strongly suggested that you use the course food services.
- While galleries are permitted, observers must use designated paths, and all are reminded of the "no advice" rule, as well as all the other rules of Golf etiquette.
- Spectators are expected to adhere to the dress code of the Golf Course.
- *Electronic "range-finders" are prohibited.*

PARTICIPANT CERTIFICATES

Participant Certificates are available on the CCS secure website which is accessible to all CCS member school Athletic Directors and Principals.

SPORTSMANSHIP:

Any player or coach who is disqualified from a Play-off contest for flagrant misconduct or unsportsmanlike behavior shall be disqualified from all remaining contests in that sport that season, including CIF Nor-Cal Regional & State Championships.

PARKING:

There are plenty of parking spaces available. The course will not be charging for parking.

CIF NOR-CAL REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS:

- **STANFORD GOLF COURSE, STANFORD, CA - MONDAY, NOVEMBER 7, 2011**
 - TEAMS - Top three (3) teams from the CCS Tournament, using the five (5) best scores of six (6)-player teams, over 18 holes;
 - INDIVIDUALS - Top four (4) individuals from the CCS Tournament, over 18 holes, who are not members of a qualifying team.

CIF STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS:

- **POPPY HILLS GOLF COURSE, PEBBLE BEACH, CA - TUESDAY NOVEMBER 15, 2011**
 - TEAMS - Top three (3) teams from the CIF Nor-Cal Regional, using the five (5) best scores of six (6)-player teams, over 18 holes;
 - INDIVIDUALS - Top nine (9) individuals from the CIF Nor-Cal Regional, over 18 holes, who are not members of a qualifying team.
