IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL PARTICIPANTS AND COACHES:

The CIF-Central Coast Section is well aware that many other school and non-school activities (AP tests, SAT/ACT tests, proms, plays, holidays, senior trips, religious days, etc.) may occur during CCS Play-offs. The CCS tries to avoid as many conflicts as possible; however, with so many activities available for today's student-athlete, it is not reasonable to assume that all such activities can be taken into account, and thus, CCS Play-off events will go on as originally scheduled. Participants and coaches are therefore expected to plan in advance for such possible scheduling conflicts and make those difficult choices as to which events will take precedence for that individual. Generally, although it is ultimately the personal choice of the student-athlete and/or his/her parent(s), an academic activity should take precedence over an extra-curricular event.

PROGRAM ROSTERS:

In order to be included in the Tournament program, coaches must submit rosters on-line to Justin Peterson, the CCS Tournament Program printer at www.preppolo.com/section/ccs no later than **NOVEMBER 1st. PLEASE DO NOT SEND ROSTERS TO THE CCS OFFICE!**

TEAM BENCH:

- In first round and quarter-final matches, the host school shall be considered as the "Home" team and shall have choice of team bench. In subsequent rounds the "Home" team shall be the highest seeded team and consequently will have choice of team bench.
- Teams shall occupy the bench located on the side of the net adjacent to their playing area throughout the match.
- Only the players, coaches, team managers, statisticians, trainer and school administrative personnel will be allowed on the bench during the match.

TEAM WARM-UP PROCEDURES:

Team warm-ups will be conducted in accordance with procedures listed in the State CIF Handbook.

GAME BALL:

The official Tournament ball is **SPALDING**. For ALL Rounds, **SPALDING** Volleyballs will be used exclusively in all contests.

SCOREKEEPER / SCOREBOOK:

In first round and quarter-final matches, the host school shall be considered as the "Home" team and provide the official scorekeeper and scorebook.

REPORTING RESULTS:

It is the responsibility of all teams to report their results in a timely fashion to the media in their area, as well as texting the results to CCS at 408-887-3613. Contest results will be posted on the CCS website [www.cifccs.org] as soon as possible.

PRACTICE AT CHAMPIONSHIP SITE(S):

No arrangements for practice at competition sites are allowed by the CCS once the site of the Tournament has been announced by CCS. See "General Tournament Information" Section of the [CCS Tournament Guide](#) for specific policy. Schools found in violation of this rule may be barred from further participation in the Section Play-offs.

SPORTSMANSHIP:

It is essential that all competition be completely within the bounds of good sportsmanship.

- Each Principal is required by the CCS Board of Managers to meet with any team from his/her school participating in the CCS Tournament to review CCS Sportsmanship Information. See the [CCS Tournament Guide](#) for REQUIRED PRE-GAME SPORTSMANSHIP MEETING INFORMATION SHEET
- Coaches and Captains will meet with the Site Director 30 minutes prior to game-time to remind them of the importance of good sportsmanship and to make certain their Administrator has reviewed this information with them in the past week.
- Administrators from both schools in each contest will attend a mandatory meeting with the Site Director 15 minutes prior to game time. The coach cannot represent the school at this meeting.
- Any player or coach who is ejected from a CCS Tournament contest for FLAGRANT MISCONDUCT or UNSPORTSMANLIKE BEHAVIOR will be disqualified from all remaining contests in that sport that season.

ROOTING SECTION:

- ALL spirit-squad members must be in uniform to be admitted without charge. Spirit-squads may only perform in areas which do not obstruct play.
- NO ARTIFICIAL NOISE-MAKERS will be permitted inside the gymnasium at any CCS Volleyball match. The improper use of any devices by supporters of a team will result in cessation of the match until the device is removed.
- Only POSITIVE BANNERS/POSTERS will be allowed. No reference to opponents, either directly or indirectly, shall be made, except in a positive manner.

FACULTY SUPERVISION:

Adequate student/spectator supervision MUST be provided by each school participating in the Tournament. School administrators/faculty who attend the contest in this regard should introduce themselves to the CCS Site Director, and tell him/her where they will be located throughout the contest in case their assistance is required. It is the responsibility of the school supervisory personnel to prevent and correct any inappropriate behavior of their schools' students and spectators.

CHAMPIONSHIP T-SHIRTS:

While supplies last, CCS Championship T-shirts may be ordered online (\$15 each) using the [T-Shirt Order Form](#) on the CCS Girls Volleyball webpage. No other merchandise may be sold without CCS approval.

PARTICIPANT CERTIFICATES

Participant Certificates are available on the CCS secure website which is accessible to all CCS member school Athletic Directors and Principals.

NORCAL REGIONAL TOURNAMENT presented by Farmers:

Teams that advance to the CCS finals will qualify for the Northern California Regional Tournament.
