**MEETINGS:**

- **SEEDING MEETING: SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2011, @ 9:00am - CCS Office**  
 Entries due; [Team Entry/Line-ups & Season Summary Sheets](#) must be electronically submitted prior to the meeting. Each coach should submit signed copies at the meeting. Team Tournament seeding will be conducted first, followed by Individual Tournament seeding.
- **EVALUATION MEETING: THURSDAY, DECEMBER 1, 2011, @ 4:00pm - CCS Office**

**INCLEMENT WEATHER:**

In case of inclement weather, matches will be held the next available date, with the exception of Sunday (i.e., Thursday instead of Wednesday, etc.) until completion of play. If Team competition is delayed, then the Individual Tournament will be delayed until conclusion of the Team Tournament.

**SPORTSMANSHIP:**

Any player or coach who is disqualified from a Play-off contest for flagrant misconduct or unsportsmanlike behavior shall be disqualified from all remaining contests in that sport that season, including CIF Nor-Cal Regional Championships.

**T-SHIRT ORDERS:**

While supplies last, CCS Championship T-shirts will be available (\$15 each) at the Seeding Meeting. Pre-orders may also be ordered by completing the [T-Shirt Order Form](#) on the CCS Girls Tennis webpage. No other merchandise may be sold without CCS approval.

**PARTICIPANT CERTIFICATES**

Participant Certificates are available on the CCS secure website which is accessible to all CCS member school Athletic Directors and Principals.

**IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL PARTICIPANTS AND COACHES:**

The CIF-Central Coast Section is well aware that many other school and non-school activities (AP tests, SAT/ACT tests, proms, plays, holidays, senior trips, religious days, etc.) may occur during CCS Play-offs. The CCS tries to avoid as many conflicts as possible; however, with so many activities available for today's student-athlete, it is not reasonable to assume that all such activities can be taken into account, and thus, CCS Play-off events will go on as originally scheduled. Participants and coaches are therefore expected to plan in advance for such possible scheduling conflicts and make those difficult choices as to which events will take precedence for that individual. Generally, although it is ultimately the personal choice of the student-athlete and/or his/her parent(s), an academic activity should take precedence over an extra-curricular event.

**FORMAT**

The tournament will be a 24 team single elimination bracket using a round robin format. Each team will consist of three(3) singles players and three(3) doubles teams. [See the Girls Tennis Bylaws](#) for match procedures.

**TOURNAMENT BALLS:**

IN ALL ROUNDS PRIOR TO THE SEMI-FINALS, EACH TEAM IS EXPECTED TO SUPPLY FOUR (4) CANS OF USTA-APPROVED TENNIS BALLS FOR EACH DAY OF PLAY.

**WILSON**, the Official Tennis Ball sponsor of the Central Coast Section, will provide balls for Semi-Final and Final rounds of the Tournament.
