SUBJECT: REALIGNMENT SUB COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

As most of you know the realignment sub committee met February 2, 2005 to review any proposals submitted by member schools for realignment. The proposals received are as follows:

Sacred Heart Prep: Requested for their boys to be placed in the PAL and removed from the PSAL

CPSAL: Requested to add Kehillah Jewish school to their league, making it 12 schools and announced the plan to divide into two supplemental leagues (divisions) within the 12 schools.

The Committee considered both proposals and makes the following recommendations to the Northern Conference:

1. Kehillah Jewish school should be added to the CPSAL. (4-0 vote)
2. Sacred Heart Prep boys should remain in the PSAL, (4-0 vote)
3. Sacred Heart Prep boys soccer should be released from the PSAL and supplementally leagued in the PAL (3-1 vote)

According to the CCS Bylaws:

ARTICLE IV LEAGUE REALIGNMENT

Section 2 CONFERENCE AND LEAGUE FORMATIONS

The purpose of a Conference is established as being responsible for forming leagues among schools which have been assigned to that Conference. Such leagues shall include Basic Leagues, Supplemental Leagues, and Inter-Conference Leagues ([See Section 5 following](#)).

Section 6 CONFERENCE MEETINGS The Chairman of Each Conference shall convene a Conference meeting for the purpose of adopting Basic Leagues and to provide for the formation of Supplemental and Inter-Conference leagues and the dissolution of such Supplemental and Inter-Conference leagues.

Therefore, a meeting of all Northern Conference schools will be held at:

At least one person from each school is required to attend. The list of those approved by your board of trustees to vote in representation of each school is attached for your reference. Per CCS bylaws, the proposals will be acted upon by one vote per school. A simple majority will carry any motion except as outlined below IV.6.e).

The Conference meeting will be conducted in accordance with the following CCS Bylaw:

CCS Bylaws, Article IV, Section 6 Conference Meeting

(a)	Each school assigned to the Conference shall be represented by the principal or other person defined in the Education Code, Section, or by a school based designee of such principal or person so defined.
b)	The Conference shall consider proposals formulated by the Advisory Sub-Committee which must have been circulated 15 calendar days or more prior to the Conference meeting.
c)	The Conference shall consider proposals from any other source which have been circulated at least 10 calendar days prior to the meeting.
d)	The Conference may amend, by majority vote of those principals, persons, or designees defined above, any proposal previously circulated provided such amendment affects no more than four schools in any amended proposal.
e)	The Conference may, by consent of two-thirds of the principals, persons or designees defined above, waive the 10-day provision of this section and thereafter adopt any proposal for league formation.
